The camera ZOOMS IN on the stand, showing of an array of baked goods.

SAM

So we hope you can come support your favorite thespians by stopping by our bake sale. We really need to raise money to find a new rehearsal space because Principal Willis gave the auditorium to the football team so they could watch re-runs of Friday Night Lights. Right now, we're forced to use Ms. Graham's one bedroom apartment, and her roommates are not happy about it.

CUT TO:

Sam holding up some pies.

SAM

Mmm. These pies are so delicious that even the cast of Waitress would be jealous. We know what you're thinking didn't you use these pies in the Spring production of Sweeney Todd? Nope! We used them in the production of "Scary Barber Killer Man" because we couldn't actually afford the rights to Sweeney Todd, and seriously, we can get into a lot of trouble, so please stop asking.

CUT TO:

Two JOCKS approach the stand.

SAM  
Hi guys, would you like to support  
the Drama Club?

JOCK 1  
Sure, F\*ggot.

He smashes the pie in Sam's face as Jock 2 trips him.

CUT TO:

Sam, on the ground, looks up at the camera with a pie covered  
face.

SAM  
That's Kyle Turner, he's going to  
play D3 soccer in the fall for  
Greenview Community. He's so cool.

CUT TO:

Sam holds up a basket of Olive Garden breadsticks.

SAM  
Mamma Mia. Sweets aren't your  
thing? No problem. We also have a  
basket of Olive Garden breadsticks  
that Ms. Graham swiped from her  
shift bussing tables last night.  
There's a few bites taken out of  
them, but they're as good as new.

Sam takes a bite out of one and grimaces.

SAM  
Mmm. I feel transported to Italy  
already.

CUT TO:

Sam stands in front of his stand.

SAM  
All baked goods are selling for the  
low low price of fifteen dollars.  
Think that's steep? Remember you're  
paying for dinner AND a show.  
That's right, Greenview's finest  
will also be performing the  
choreography of "It's a Hard Knock  
Life" from Annie.  
(MORE)

SAM (CONT'D)

Mostly because a lot of it is just cleaning, and that's kind of our job now that they laid off so many of the custodial staff.

CUT TO:

Sam addressing the camera.

SAM

Not hungry? No worries. We're also selling raffle tickets. That's right for just five dollars you can enter to win this \$50 Denny's gift card. The manager was so graceful in donating this as long as we promised to stop coming in, and asking their patrons for spare change.

CUT TO:

New shot.

SAM

Or what about face painting? Bring along the little ones to get their face painted by Ms. Graham. She learned how to do this while studying at the Oxford School of Drama...Three dollars.

CUT TO:

Yet again, new shot.

SAM

Remember, this is for a good cause. We not only need a new rehearsal space, but we're in dire need of new costumes. Last Fall, the SPCA brought in a bunch of strays to cover some of the ensemble parts in our production of "CATS" and one of them crawled into our costume bin and had babies...then she died.

A beat.

SAM

And I'm not sure if that cat was totally healthy, because so far those costumes have put three freshmen in the hospital.

Another beat.

SAM

Also, side note, the Becca Johnson memorial chocolate bar sale starts next Monday.

A memorial of BECCA JOHNSON appears on screen.

CUT TO:

New shot.

SAM

So please come on by and support your local drama club-

The camera pans over to the Jocks washing cars, Sam intervenes.

SAM

No, no that's not apart of our thing. The baseball team is raining money for Coach Cooper's second convertible.

SMASH CUT TO:

The jocks approach Sam.

SAM

Oh, hey guys!

JOCK 1

You talking shit?

SAM

No, no, I wasn't-

They turn the hose on Sam, spraying him down as he screams.

SMASH CUT TO:

Sam is two inches away from the camera, soaking wet.

SAM

Okay we need to cut, just stop recording, just press the button, I don't know-

SMASH CUT TO:

SUPER: DRAMA CLUB BAKE SALE! THIS FRIDAY AT TWO!

BLACKOUT.
